In 2025, 4.18 million Americans will turn 65, which is a record high. This is equivalent to about 11,400 people turning 65 each day. An estimated 40,000 Missourians are projected to turn 65 in 2025. If you are working for a small employer, or part time, or maybe don't have insurance, then please enroll! Big decision: original Medicare with a supplement and Part D, or, Medicare Advantage. This is a big decision and can have future consequences which is why you want to be fully informed before making this decision. With a little over half of the people in Medicare Advantage and little less than half in original Medicare, this tells me there is not a clear winner. The decision should be based on your health, your lifestyle and your finances, mostly These are issues that SHIP counselor will discuss with you and make sure you have considered all the options. A great resource is the Medicare and You book which is published every year by Medicare. You can request one from Medicare, the Missouri SHIP off (1800-390-3330) or you can find it published onlin A SHIP counselor will also screen everyone for any additional help from the State of Missouri or Social Security that can help reduce costs. 



Mobile Integrated Healthcare (MIH) is a patient-centered, innovative delivery model offering on-demand, needs-based care and preventive services, delivered in the patient's home or mobile environment. CPs and CHWs make regular home visits and offer the following care:

- Basic preventive care, including detailed assessments, vital signs, lab draws, EKGs, ultrasounds, wound care, and IV infusions
- Home safety assessments
- Medication reconciliation
- Facilitation of telehealth visits with providers
- Focus on addressing social determinants of health
- Care coordination, primary care provider enrollment, and Medicaid navigation

Patients can refer themselves to the program or be referred by a healthcare provider, emergency medical services (EMS) provider, or hospital emergency department upon discharge.
